Getting to Downtown Amherst

Downtown Amherst is 1.5 miles from Hotel UMass. To get there, you may walk through campus and town, which takes approximately a ½ hour. Alternatively, you may call a taxi (ask Hotel Main Desk for information), which will take 5 minutes. If you are driving, there is parking available downtown.
